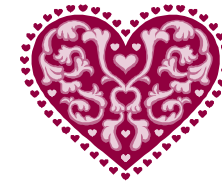

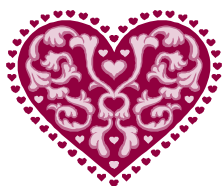

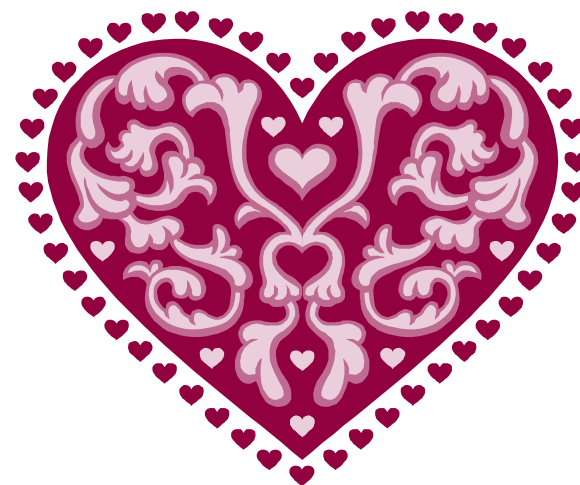


Immediately following the recessional,
